EXAM DAY CHECKLIST

Before the exam:		
• Make	sure you know: the date, time, duration and location of each exam – maybe write these details on a calendar or planner.	
	who to contact at school or college in case there is an emergency that makes you late or unable to sit the exam.	
	be prepared with what equipment you will need for each exam	

What you will need:		
	a clear pencil case.	
	black pens – bring at least two. Gel pens are not allowed.	
	an approved calculator.	
	appropriate equipment such as a ruler, protractor or compass for relevant exams.	
	a clear water bottle if you decide to take one in – it must not have a label.	

What you cannot take into the exam:		
	a mobile phone or any other electronic device.	
	any type of watch (this includes analogue, digital and smart watches)	
	any revision notes.	

Other important information

- Be on time! If you are late, you will disrupt others and may not be able to sit the exam.
- Listen carefully to what the invigilator is telling you. If you are unsure of anything, raise your hand and wait for the invigilator.
- If you need additional answer sheets, raise your hand and what for an invigilator to provide you with one.
- If you need to use the toilet or are feeling unwell, raise your hand and wait to be escorted from the exam room.
- Don't talk or try to disturb other candidates once the exam has started this can lead to disqualification.
- Don't leave the exam room until you have been given permission to do so.
